

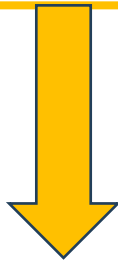


Potential PPL and PIL breach

Home Office Outcome: Letter of Inspector Advice

What happened?

A verbal request was made to a PIL holder to carry out a regulated procedure on an animal that was not authorised in the PPL protocol.



Why did we have to report it?

PIL SC 9

PIL holders are responsible for ensuring they only perform regulated procedures that are authorised in the PPL protocol.



What did we do?

It was reinforced with the PIL holder that they must ensure authorities are in place before performing any regulated procedures.

The person that verbally requested the procedure was also shown the Letter of Inspector Advice, so they understood the risk and impact of requesting potentially unauthorised procedures.

PIL Standard Conditions

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The licence holder must take all reasonable steps to ensure appropriate personal and project licence authorities exist before performing regulated procedures. The licence holder must be aware of the nature of the authorities given by this licence and the project licence, and of the conditions of issue attached to the licences.
