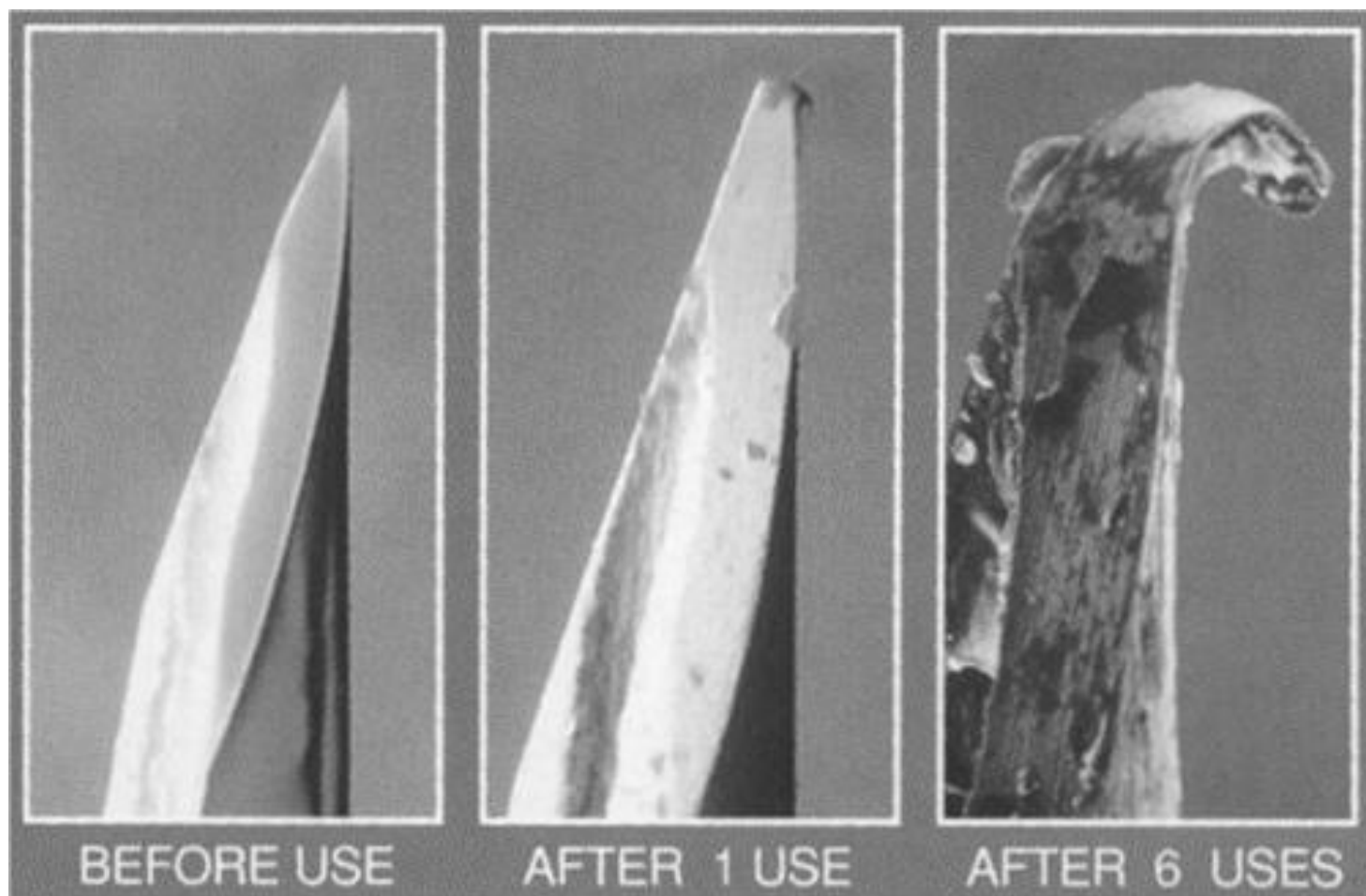


UBS Re-Use of Needles
