Researchers in are trialling the use of the Marker pens to identify mice. It does not work on black mice but it is being used on skin graft mice to avoid scruffing them. It is also being trialled on ears to avoid ear notching. Will send the information as it was felt would also like to try the pens alongside the RFID tag at the same time as surgery.
have had issues with the animals chewing the cement down to the scalp under the caps on the skull. are looking at a divider for each cage so the animals do not need to be housed individually, they will still have sight and be able to smell each other. The caps will be refined eventually so they are not as big.

Four people were invited to an interview at on Monday, none of them responded to the invitation.


c) What is happening with researchers in your unit?
