#### 1. Project Licences

#### a) Amendment:

The committee discussed the following:

- The removal of specific references from the Project Plan.
- Several typographical errors that require amending.
- Rewording required in Protocol 6.
- Further updating of animal numbers in Protocol 11.
- Further information around adverse effects and end points for specific animal strains in Protocol 13.
- The inclusion of weekly weigh-ins for monitoring purposes adding to Protocols 6 and 13.
- The recommendation that an attempt (with the support of UBS facility staff) to breed out specific adverse effects from certain animal lines is made.
- Updating of the Non-Technical Summary so that it reflects the amendments requested.
- The recommendation that the researcher provides a report for the AWERB committee in six months' time outlining the steps taken to breed specific adverse effects out of the animal line and how this has been progressing.

The committee agreed changes should be made before a draft is submitted to the Home Office.

- Further information regarding the reasons why Protocol 1 was more extensively used in Section 2.5.
- Further information around animal numbers in Section 2.5 across various protocols.
- The addition of a sample size calculation added to Section 2.8.
- Further justification around why the researcher was not able to refine contingent harms in Section 2.10.
- The recommendation that statements included in Section 2.3 could also be repeated in the Replacement section.
- Specific information included in Section 2.8 should also be included in Section 3.2.
- Further information included in Section 3.7 as well as the percentage of mortality reduction.
- The committee wished to commend the researcher regarding the information included in Section 3.7 and 3.8.

# The committee discussed the following:

- Clarification required in regards to the amount of animals used.
- Section 2.5 requires amending to reflect the correct number of animals used.
- Further update required in Section 2.9.
